I look forward to seeing everyone in Lodge for Brotherhood and Friendship!

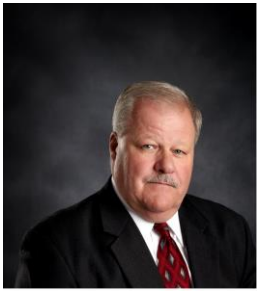

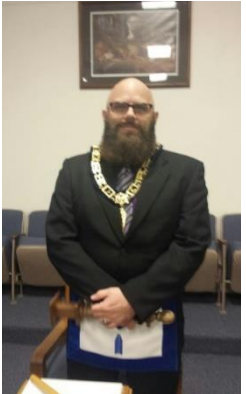

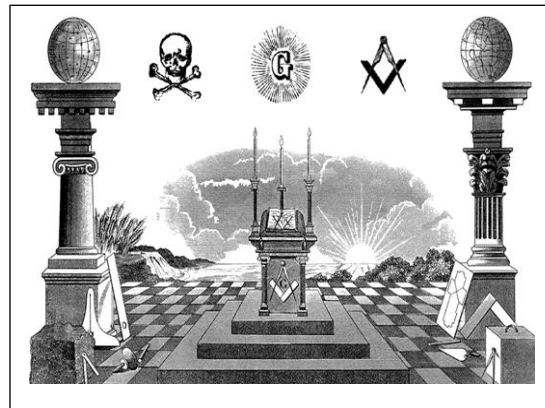

Lodge Location and Phone Number



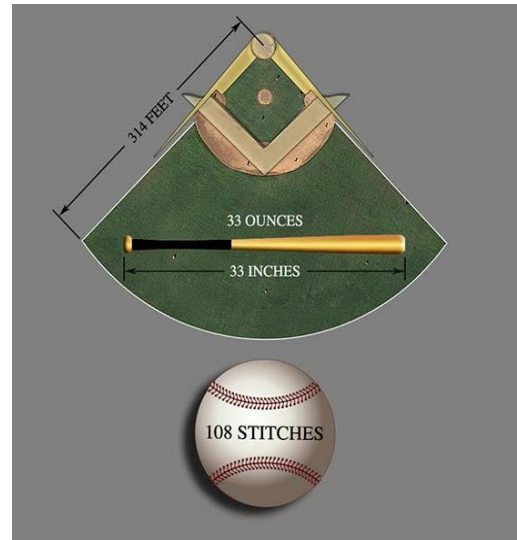
