New Lodge Projects for 2019

As your newly installed Worshipful Master I am declaring several changes that should benefit your lodge in the long run. First, I have established a lodge vision and mission:

Vision --- Eddy Lodge #21 provides visibility to the local communities ensuring a positive reflection of the Craft while maintaining a fiscally responsible management structure supporting community participation and Lodge projects.

Mission --- To establish a long-term manageable business model and a practiced ritual structure that provides for personal and moral development for our craft creating a platform for successful and responsible membership while demonstrating visible support to local communities.

To achieve the mission and make the vision come to fruition, I am declaring the establishment of four (4) new **STANDING COMMITTEES:**

- 1. Ways, Means, and Accounts Committee (WM, SW, Secretary, Treasure, and a selected Past Master*) (WB Rick Coy Chairman)
- 2. Building Maintenance and Planning Committee (SW, Stewards, SD, and a select Past Master) (Bro. Brian Burke, Chairman)
- 3. Public Relations and Outreach Committee (SW, JW, New Masons and a select Past Master) (Bro. Roman Villareal Chairman)
- 4. Charity and Scholarship Committee (SW, Select Past Master, Deacons, New Masons) (WB Ron Sanders, Chairman)

In order to improve our ritual structure and develop the moral and academic fabric of our membership, I am also declaring the establishment of three (3) Special Committees:

- Masonic Education Committee (SW, JW, New Masons, and at least one member in Lodge of Research)
 (WB Rob Perozynski Chairman)
- Coaching and Mentorship Committee (SW, SD, Past Masters, Select Coaches) (Bro. Jeff Robertson Chairman)
- Ritual Committee (WM, Degree Teams, Past Masters and New Members as appropriate) (WB Ken Johnson Chairman)

<u>Each Committee chairman</u> is responsible to develop a budget request for submission to the Ways Means, and Accounts Committee and will report progress, issues, and needs for their respective committees in open Lodge. This should provide a higher degree of transparency of budget needs and Lodge finances for the membership.

<u>The Senior Warden</u> is accountable to manage and ensure the progress of each candidate as they progress through their degree proficiencies, therefore the Coaching and Mentorship Committee Chair will provide a report directly to the SW who will then present in open lodge any progress or lack of progress of the candidates. We lose too many good men after initiation and it is thought that this process will put an end to that problem for Eddy Lodge #21.

Each Committee has a Mission statement to meet and all budget requests shall be discussed with the Ways, Means, and Accounts Committee. A budget will be formulated beginning in January and voted upon in Open Lodge by the membership during the Stated Communication held on February 7, 2019.
