#### **Proposed Change to Grand Lodge Constitution**

#### **Current Language in the Constitution**

Code 191. ADVANCEMENT. (a) No candidate shall receive more than one degree at the same communication. Before advancing from one degree to another the candidate must, at a regular or special communication, pass satisfactory proficiency examination on the proficiency lecture covering the first section of the preceding degree or pass a satisfactory examination covering the steps, signs, tokens and obligation of the preceding degree, to be determined by the majority vote of the members present. This examination may be conducted by a committee appointed by the Master. (b) Examination committees shall consist of at least three (3) members of the examining Lodge.

#### **PROPOSED CHANGE Revision of Code 191**

Rev: 1, December 10, 2018 and discussed and accepted in January 3rd 2019 Stated Communication

**CHAPTER V – CONFERRING OF DEGREES** 

#### **Code 191. ADVANCEMENT**

- A. No candidate shall receive more than one degree at the same communication.
- B. A period of at least 30 days shall elapse between the conferral of degrees.
- C-1. After conferral of a degree and before conferral of the next, the candidate shall pass a proficiency examination on the first section of that degree using the appropriate section of the current version of the Ritual Cypher, The Grand Lodge of New Mexico, AF&AM. The examination shall be performed at a regular or special communication. A pass shall consist of a majority vote of Master Masons present at that communication.
- C-2. With the majority approval of the Master Masons at a regular or special communication, the examination may be modified to cover only the steps, signs, tokens, working tools, word(s) and obligation of the preceding degree based on the current version of the Ritual Cypher, The Grand Lodge of New Mexico, AF&AM. Any such approval does NOT imply or confer approval for use of the modified form at any subsequence examination(s). If approved the examination shall be performed at the next regular or special communication. A pass shall consist of a majority vote of Master Masons present at that communication.
- C-3. With the majority approval of the Master Masons present at a regular or special communication, the Master shall appoint an examination committee of at least three Master Masons. At a time of their choosing, the committee shall proceed with the examination as determined in 191.C.1 or 191.C.2 and shall make their recommendation as to the adequacy of the proficiency examination at the next regular or special communication. A pass shall consist of a majority vote of Master Masons present at that communication.



Three Targeted Efforts of Charity as Requested by the Worshipful Master

- 1. We are <u>collecting non-perishable foods</u> (At the Lodge) for Jonah's Pantry to feed the needy in the local area. You can help by bringing in canned vegetables, proteins, rice, etc. OR any non-perishable food you wish <u>every time</u> you come to lodge. The one requirement is that you must ensure the "best by date" is as far out in the future as possible... 1 or 2 years. This permits us to store the supply until we have a pickup full to deliver to the food pantry for use.
- 2. We are working with the <u>Battered Families' Shelter</u> to provide toiletries, and other personal material needs for the ladies and their children to help them through their unfortunate and stressful times. Eddy Lodge #21 is happy to announce a donation of \$800.00 to the shelter.
- 3. We are investigating the possibly of working with Local Law Enforcement to ascertain IF the <u>Teddy Bear Program</u> should be reinstated by the Lodge. Children face terrifying stress during accidents, domestic violence, and other unfortunate events in their lives. Our first responders are able to bring assistance, and more importantly moral support to those in distress. Our lodge could offer Teddy Bear handouts for the children involved to help mitigate their fears and provide a calming effect.
