Targeted Efforts of Charity as Requested by the Worshipful Master

- 1. We are <u>collecting non-perishable foods</u> (At the Lodge) for Jonah's Pantry to feed the needy in the local area. You can help by bringing in canned vegetables, proteins, rice, etc. OR any non-perishable food you wish <u>every time</u> you come to lodge. The one requirement is that you must ensure the "best by date" is as far out in the future as possible... 1 or 2 years. This permits us to store the supply until we have a pickup full to deliver to the food pantry for use.
- 2. We are working with the <u>Battered Families' Shelter</u> to provide toiletries, and other personal material needs for the ladies and their children to help them through their unfortunate and stressful times. Eddy Lodge #21 is happy to announce that we worked with Lowe's to deliver a 20.9 cu ft freezer to the Carlsbad Battered Families Shelter. Brothers Brian Burke and Emory Johnston worked with Lowe's management on pricing and as it turned out LOWE's donated the Freezer free. See pic below.

In the first 100 days of sitting in the East, I am happy to report that Eddy Lodge #21 has accomplished many objectives by a great team of Officers and Members. These objectives were laid out in December 2018 and presented in Lodge in January 2019. Here is a summary of the actions of Eddy Lodge #21:

- Represented Eddy Lodge by attending the MLK parade in Albuquerque with the Grand Lodge
- Attended the MLK parade in Carlsbad with Prince Hall Roswell #11
- Established Stated and Special Committees to control Lodge Functions and Operations
- Created and Executed a business plan that includes an annual budget WB Rick Coy Chairman of the
 Ways, Means, and Accounts committee focusing on Lodge Renovations in three phases
- Created and Executed a Coaching and Mentorship Committee to monitor Candidate development --Chaired by Bro. Jeffery Robertson
- Created and Executed a Charities and Scholarship Committee to enhance our contribution to meeting the needs of our local/regional communities -- chaired by WB Ron Sanders
- Crated and executed a Public Relations and Outreach Committee in the Community -- chaired by Bro.
 Roman Villarreal
- Executed a Masonic Education Committee -- chaired by WB Rob Perozynski
- Created and Executed a Ritual Committee chaired by RWB Ken Johnson
- Through a request of our Life Members for donation assistance, we received a VERY GENEROUS amount of much needed monies used to renovating the Lodge.
- Developed and executed Phase I of a 3- Phase Lodge Renovation Project Bro. Brian Burke-Chairman of the Building Maintenance and Planning Committee
 - Tile in Tyler's room and Prep Room including the Hallway connecting these rooms was removed
 - Carpet Ordered for the Tyler's room and Prep Room and laying of Carpet scheduled for completion in early April
 - Plaster cracks in the wall of the Tyler's room repaired and Painting to begin Saturday March 30,
 2019
 - Purchased LED light fixtures for the Kitchen and Recreation Room to be installed in April
 - Bro. Jeremy Bolduc fixed our vandalized outside faucet in front of building
 - Exit Signs and Battery backup lighting selected by Bro. Emory Johnston (JD) and soon to be ordered and installed
 - New Fire Extinguishers selected and soon installed in locations for quick access
 - Security Cameras donated by Bro. Roberto Moran (SS) to be installed prior to July 31, 2019
 - Bros. Jeffery Robertson (SD) and Calvin Baker (JS) are working on updating the Membership Board
 - IT systems website SSL Certificate, Website Hosting and Website Domain purchase is underway by Bro. Roman Villarreal (JW)
 - Crash Bars for quick emergency egress purchased from Crews Glass and plan to be installed in mid-April
 - o Roof was cleaned of debris and other downspout clogging material

Community Charity Work

- Charitable work in the community included an \$800.00 donation to the Carlsbad Battered Families Shelter to purchase toiletries and toys for the families staying there.
- A joint Food Drive with Artesia #18 Order of Eastern Star for Jonah's Pantry is on-going with planned delivery in late May
- Eddy Lodge #21 worked with Lowes to provide a 20.9 cu ft Freezer to the Carlsbad Battered Families Shelter. Lowes donated the freezer outright and Eddy Lodge #21 delivered.
- Eddy Lodge #21 has provided camping equipment for the Girl Scout Troop #12926 and strongly support their efforts in the community and their growth as an organization
- The lodge has made progress in pursuing the Scholarship Program with contacts in both Loving and Carlsbad High Schools. We expect an award to be provided in late April early May timeframe for both schools.
