## 2019 Accomplishments for Eddy Lodge # 21

**Battered Women's Shelter** we provided cooked meals, collaborated with LOWE's to deliver a new 15 cuft freezer to the Shelter, and provided \$800 to purchase toiletries for the patrons, and through the efforts of Bro. Calvin Baker and his wife, provided much needed children's clothing.

Community food bank - Food drive A very successful effort that involved all Masons and the Artesia No. 18 - Order of the Easter Star to provide canned goods, boxed goods, etc. for delivery to the community Food Bank.

Successfully raised funds for our Building fund drive using Membership Donation Flyer. We raised a considerable amount of funds to accomplish our renovation projects and OWE A GREAT DEAL OF PRAISE TO OUR PERPETUAL MEMBERS FOR THEIR GRACIOUS DONATIONS.

#### Renovations to the Lodge with the following activities:

- Egress markings (Lighted Exit signs)
- Fire Extinguishers (Placed in Strategic Locations)
- New Carpet and Painting of the Tyler's and Prep Room including hallway between
- LED Ceiling Lights replaced in Lounge and Kitchen lights in Kitchen and Lounge
- History Corner placed in NE corner of DeMolay Room
- Name plates in Membership Roster for both Eddy Lodge #21 and Artesia NO. 18 OES
- Repaired Ceiling water damage in tow Storage Rooms (SW Corner of Lodge and NW corner of Lodge)
- Hamilton Roofing performed repairs on our Roof to stop leaking in DeMolay Room and other areas
- Renovated the Kitchen by removing the old wall ovens and cabinet and the sink and replacing them with two-ranges and a new deep 3-bowl stainless steel commercial sink and stainless steel work table.
- Installed white board paneling in the Kitchen for easy cleaning
- Cleaned and removed OLD non-usable kitchen equipment and utensils
- Installed CRASH bars on the Front Doors for quick egress outside in an emergency
- Purchased new Emergency First Aid kit


