EDIT #1 Issued on May 23, 2021 is summarized below:

The Most Worshipful Grand Master Baker immediately issued Edict 1 under his authority that essentially keeps the restrictions previously ordered under Most Worshipful Brother Easley in place until further notice.

However, Eddy Lodge #21 is still performing ZOOM meetings. The next ZOOM Meeting for Eddy Lodge #21 will be conducted on June 4, 2020 at 7:00 pm. This would coincide with our Regularly Stated Communications.

The Lodge is permitted to conduct "BUSINESS" but no Lodge Work (Ritual) can be performed. Eddy Lodge #21 can accept Petitions and perform investigations, Proficiency Training, etc. We will NOT be able to perform any degree work until the restrictions are lifted.

Memorial Day

A "tidbit" of information on Flag Etiquette

Flag Etiquette and Memorial Day



You may not be aware of this little-known fact in Flag etiquette!


An easy way to remember when to fly the United States flag at half-staff is to consider when the whole nation is in mourning.

On Memorial Day the flag should be flown at half-staff from <u>sunrise until</u> <u>noon only</u>, then raised briskly to the top of the staff until sunset, in honor of the nation's battle heroes. This custom, unique to Memorial Day, honors the war dead in the morning of Memorial Day, but then the flag is raised to full-staff at noon by the living, "who resolve not to let their sacrifice be in vain, but to rise up in their stead and continue the fight for liberty and justice for all." (Title 4 USC)

The flag should be briskly run up to the top of the staff before being lowered slowly to the half-staff position.
